



Boh joins sister Bic on show-stopping tour

It wasn't that long ago that Boh Runga came to Hawke's Bay but this time she is out of the churches and into the wineries for the More FM Winery Tour.

It has proved to be a winning formula, with a sold-out crowd already booked for the Black Barn Vineyard stop-off on February 19.

But Sacred Hill Wines still has tickets available for its February 21 show at the Rifleman's Vineyard.

Headlined by Boh's sister Bic, who will perform with Tim Finn and Dave Dobbyn, the tour recreates the original 2000 Finn, Runga, Dobbyn tour.

This time Boh will join the line-up, warming up the crowd and sharing the stage with R&B singer Che Fu.

"It is really exciting because I get to hang out with my sister on the road.

"She's one of my best friends as well as my sister," she said.

Boh kept her sister company almost 10 years ago when she took to the road on the original Finn, Runga, Dobbyn tour.

"They haven't done that for the longest time, and it's going to be amazing to see and hear those guys sing again.

"It was a really, really good show. All three of them are such amazing songwriters and great performers.

"It was a real power-packed show and, 10 years down the track, there are new songs."

It was the idea of Boh's husband, music promoter Campbell Smith, to pair his wife with Che Fu as the opening act for the winery tour.

The two singers have known each

other for years but have never performed together.

With an 18-date schedule over 29 days from Tutukaka to Arrowtown, there won't be much time for enjoying the scenery. But there will be a party wherever they go.
